Tree survey outcomes

Last month we sent letters to local residents sharing an update on the result of the tree surveys that were carried out in **October 2024**.

The results of the surveys found that three of the poplar trees on Glenhurst Avenue have significant internal decay, and need to be removed and replaced for health and safety reasons.

The letter outlined the decision made by Camden's Trees Team to remove and replace the trees, and information on next steps for this process.

Feedback on designs shown in July

Below is a reminder of the key feedback we received at the developing design ideas event:



Materials and style

Materials should respond to the existing architecture and preferred choices that would be simple and elegant rather than overcomplicated or fussy



Landscape

Modest landscape interventions that were greener and more playful, and the idea of planters for residents were well received



Height and massing

Concerns that height and massing could have a negative impact on neighbouring homes



Facilities

Requests for clarity on how new bins and waste management will be resolved



Safety

Requests for more information on how the proposals will work to address concerns about safety and anti-social behaviour on the estate.

What's happening now?

Alongside reviewing your feedback, the design team are working to address the new circumstances around the trees before coming back with final designs in the new year.

The decision to remove and replace the trees responds to a health and safety issue and has been taken independently from the New Homes for Small Sites Programme.

We do not anticipate the removal of the trees to have a significant impact on the proposed designs shown in July 2024.

More information on updated designs, including landscaping improvements, will be available at the next engagement event in early 2025.
